Pursuant to Section 482.302, Government Code, the Texas Space Commission (Commission) must provide written notification to the Legislative Budget Board not later than the thirtieth day after a grant award is made from the Space Exploration and Aeronautics Research Fund (SEARF).

Accordingly, this letter serves as notice that the Commission has awarded up to \$8,200,000.00 to Firefly Aerospace, Inc. (Firefly) for construction and equipment costs incurred to expand development capabilities as well as capacity regarding spacecraft production – including additional cleanrooms and hardware – at a Spacecraft Development Center in Cedar Park. Both parties fully executed a Grant Agreement dated today.
